CC-WARE the project: **Mitigating Vulnerability of Water Resources under Climate Change**

CC-WARE aims at developing an integrated transnational strategy for drinking water protection and mitigating water resources vulnerability under climate change building the basis for an implementation of national or regional action plans leveraging the potentials of ecosystem services, land use change, improved water use efficiency and economic incentives.

Within this project the present and future quantity and quality vulnerability of drinking water resources will be assessed by means of vulnerability indicators considering climate change and socio-economic conditions. The result will be a transnational SEE vulnerability map of drinking water resources.

Different water management options for water supply systems with focus on ecosystem services of various ecosystems (forests, wetlands and grasslands) will be evaluated and land use regulations analysed to propose improvements for assuring a sustainable drinking water supply. Additionally a common catalogue of recommendations for economic incentives for efficient water management will be jointly elaborated based on experiences from water suppliers and best practice examples.

Derived from these results a framework on the national level of all project partners for the implementation of the strategy developed on transnational level considering legislation and institutional structures will be setup. The gained knowledge will be transferred especially to pre-accession countries.

Participants: policy makers, stakeholders and experts of national and regional institutions (e.g. federal ministries, regional authorities) from all SEE countries, especially pre-accession countries (e.g. Albania, Bosnia-Herzegovina, FYROM, Moldavia, Montenegro and Ukraine), project partners, European permanent representatives of SEE partner countries, representatives of the coordination of Danube Region, UNESCO and many more.

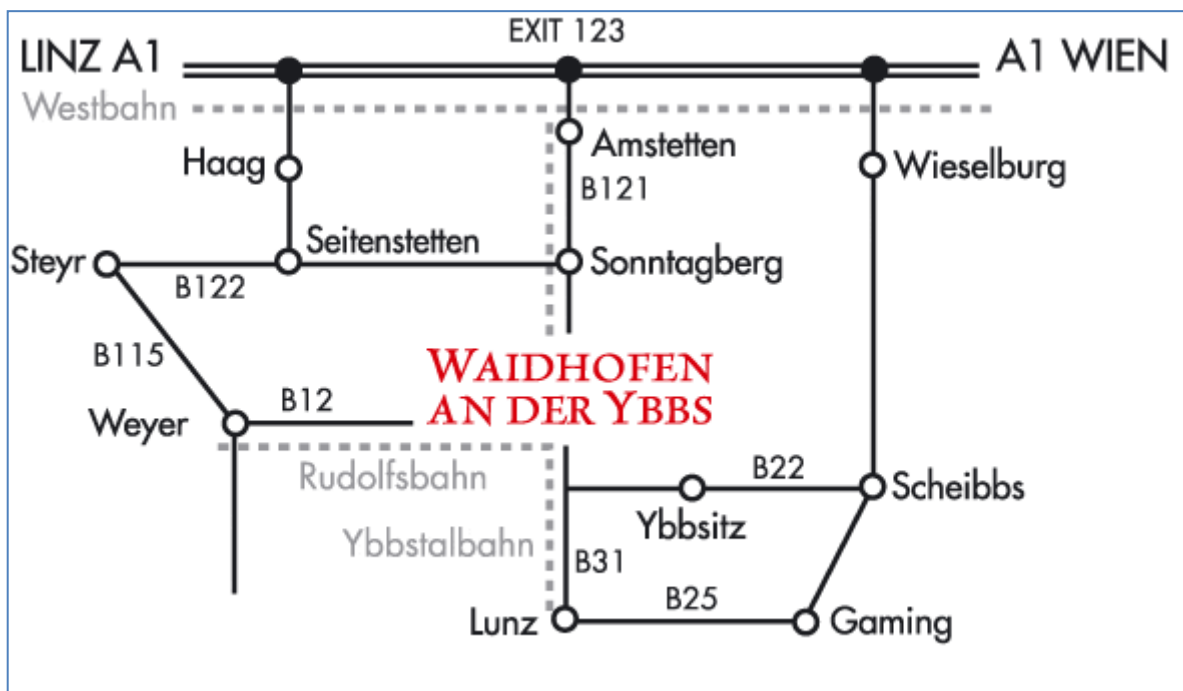
